### Spencer Butte Neighborhood Association (SBNA)

Formed as a social organization in 1953, Spencer Butte Neighborhood Association (SBNA) has expanded to offer community education and awareness to keep neighbors connected and informed about local issues and concerns. This then also promotes safety and security throughout the neighborhood. ### Emergency Fire and Medical Services for the SBNA area

**Eugene Rural Fire Protection District #1** is responsible for fire and medical emergency services for the SBNA area. They contract with **Eugene Springfield Fire** to provide those services for the SBNA area, except for homes west of Praise Lane. **Nextdoor.com** also has a Spencer Butte area group and provides information and discussion opportunities beyond the SBNA area. They determine your group based on your address (which they verify with neighbors). There is a digest option to minimize the number of emails.
